New Intake Evening - Thursday 4th July

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to give you some information about our 'New Intake Evening' for parents/carers and students on Thursday 4th July from 5.30pm - 7.30pm at our Borrington Road Site. During the evening there will be an opportunity for parents/carers to meet senior staff, the head of Year 7, form tutors, our head boy/girl and listen to our vision of education for our students. We would very much like to see you on this evening, accompanied by your son/daughter. Unfortunately, lack of space prevents us from inviting other members of the family.

The schedule for the evening will be as follows (please note that details of your son/daughter's tutor group will be sent to all primary schools in due course):

- 5.30pm Arrive at the Borrington Site
- 5.30pm **Tutor groups 7B1, 7B2, 7B3** go to main hall (headteacher's welcome and information from head of Year 7 and the head boy and girl).
- Tutor groups 7C1, 7C2, 7Q1, 7Q2** go to gym (head of Borrington Site's welcome, presentation on internet safety, The Appeal Trust, homework, literacy and the importance of reading).
- 6.10pm **Tutor groups 7C1, 7C2, 7Q1, 7Q2** go to main hall (headteacher's welcome and information from head of Year 7 and the head boy and girl).
- Tutor groups 7B1, 7B2, 7B3** go to gym (head of Borrington Site's welcome, presentation on internet safety, The Appeal Trust, homework, literacy and the importance of reading).
- 6.45pm All students and their parents/carers have the chance to meet with form tutors in their tutor rooms.
- 7.30pm Evening ends.

Unfortunately parking on and around the Borrington Site for the evening will be very limited. A small amount of parking will be available on site and we are investigating the possibility of using Comberton Primary School for additional parking. It would be very helpful if you could arrange to share a car to reduce the number of vehicles coming on to the site and surrounding area.

I would be grateful if you would read the information and discuss its content with your son/daughter before completing the green forms and any of the other forms that are applicable, which can be found at the back of the booklet.
