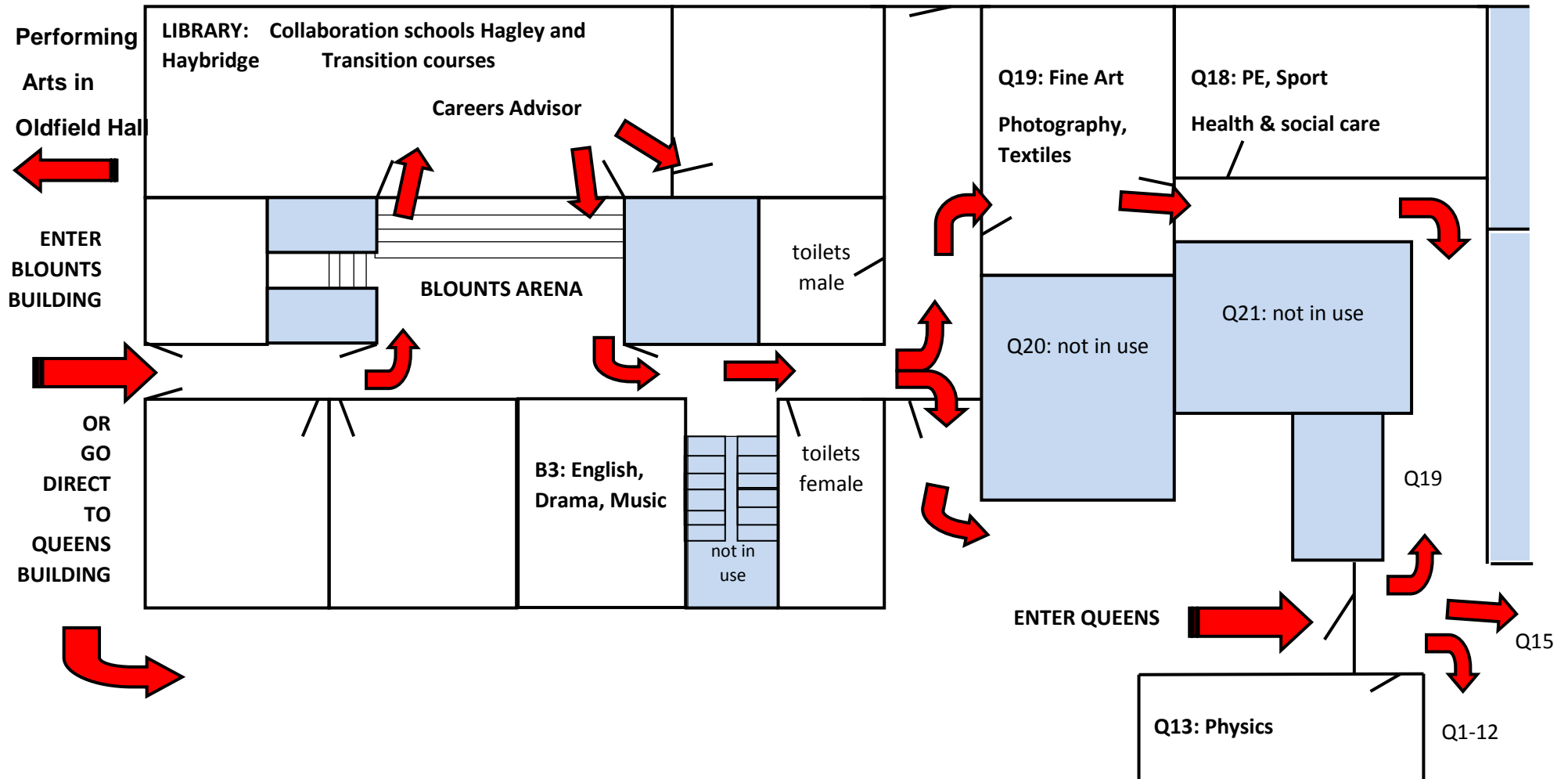
Students and parents/carers are welcome to visit subject stands between 6pm and 8.00pm.
