## Equality Objectives 2015-16 review

*The governing body adopted these short term objectives on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2015 and they were included in our action plans for the 2015-16 academic year. The review was discussed and agreed on The governing body adopted these objectives on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2016.*

### Objectives for the 2015/16 year

#### Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11

1. Improve the attainment and achievement of the boys so that the gap between the Progress 8 score of the boys and girls is substantially narrowed.
2. Improve the attendance of the females eligible for the pupil premium so that the gap between the attendance of these students and their peers is substantially narrowed.
3. Reduce the number of exclusions for boys so that the gap between the number for boys and that for girls is substantially narrowed.

#### Review: Objective 1

The gap between the Progress 8 score of the boys and girls has slightly narrowed.

#### Review: Objective 2

The attendance of the females eligible for the pupil premium decreased from 2014/15 to 2015/16 and so the gap with the boys increased.

Percentage attendance for the first two terms	2014/15	2015/16
Females eligible for FSM	94.4	92.7
Males eligible for FSM	95.0	94.5
Gap	-0.6	-1.8

#### Review: Objective 3

The number of exclusions for boys slightly reduced from 2014/15 to 2015/16 and so did the gap with the girls.

Girls	3	5
