Equality Objectives 2016-17 review

The governing body adopted these short term objectives on Thursday 22nd September 2016 and they were included in our action plans for the 2016-17 academic year. The review was discussed and agreed on Wednesday 20th September 2017.

Objectives for the 2016/17 year

Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11

1. Improve the attainment and achievement of the boys so that the gap between the Progress 8 score of the boys and girls is substantially narrowed.
2. Improve the attendance of the females eligible for the pupil premium so that the gap between the attendance of these students and their peers is substantially narrowed.
3. Reduce the number of exclusions for boys so that the gap between the number for boys and that for girls is substantially narrowed.

Years 12 and 13

4. Improve the progress of the girls on academic and A Level subjects so that they make the same progress as the boys.

Review: Objective 1

The gap between the Progress 8 score of the boys and girls has significantly increased.

Review: Objective 2

The attendance of the females eligible for the pupil premium increased from 2015/16 to 2016/17 and the gap with the boys significantly decreased.

Review: Objective 3

The number of exclusions for boys and the gap with the girls slightly increased from 2015/16 to 2016/17.

Review: Objective 4

The gap between the progress (A Level value added) of the boys and girls has slightly increased.
