Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope that your son/daughter is getting excited about starting King Charles I School. Staff are delighted that we will be meeting them next week and Mr Males the head of year has been very impressed with what he has heard from their primary school teachers. Mr Males and Mrs Morgan have been communicating with Year 6 teachers over the last few weeks so we have as much information about your son/daughter. Mrs Morgan would like to thank those parents who attended the Year 6 SEND coffee morning on Friday, which we felt was a great success. We want to encourage positive communication to ensure all students are supported in the right way both at school and at home. We encourage parents/carers to contact us if there are concerns that need to be addressed and also contact us with positive feedback.

Last week you should have received email correspondence which included two letters. The New Intake evening letter and the Free School Meal application letter. Please read them carefully and we are looking forward to meeting you on Wednesday 29th June 2022. During your son/daughter's transition days the main aims are to ensure they have the opportunity to get to know us, fellow students; become familiar with the site and some of our routines before they start in September. They will have lots of opportunities to ask questions to make sure we have covered all of the things they might be thinking about.

I would like to direct your attention to some important aspects in these letters. The 'free school meals' letter provides information about eligibility the application process.

The 'parent/carers information pack' has a wealth of information, all of which can be found on our website. Please study this carefully and complete the home school agreement and permissions section, which can be completed by clicking on the link [agreement/permission form](#). It is important that all parties understand these expectations and agree to work in partnership for the benefit of all students. It is vital that the home school agreement and permissions forms are completed no later than Friday 24th June.



Bridging tasks

As a school we have put together a number of subject bridging tasks for students to complete/study in the summer term. It includes:

- English writing tasks
- A range of additional subject tasks.

These tasks are designed to support students moving to secondary school and it is important not to worry or become anxious if some tasks are too hard or not all are completed. These can be completed in the exercise book being issued in the transition. Students will also receive a reading book during their transition days, which will need to be read before starting King Charles I School in September.
